

The Priority Services Register (PSR) is a free service and provides extra support for people with health, communication, or safety needs.

It provides you with extra help from your utility company if the power, gas, or water goes off in an emergency – or because of planned works.

You could be eligible if you:

- Use medical equipment reliant on electricity or water
- · Are pregnant or live with children under five
- · Are blind or partially sighted
- · Are deaf or hard of hearing
- Have anxiety, depression or any mental health condition
- · Have a disability or a chronic illness
- · Are of pensionable age
- · Have a loss or impairment of smell
- Need documents translated into another format or language
- Temporarily need extra support due to life changes

There are many reasons you could be eligible to register for free.

Put a lid on it

Putting a lid on your pan helps water to boil faster so you use less energy.

Do not over fill

Only boil as much as you need. Save £10 a year by not overfilling your kettle.

Switching off

Turning off lights and switching appliances off standby when not in use can save you £52 a year.

Turn it down

By turning down your thermostat from 22°C to 21°C, you could save £85 per year.

Full loads

Wash with a full load! Cutting back on one cycle a week can save you £12 a year.

LED lights

Switching your lights to energy-friendly LED light bulbs can save you around £40 a year.
